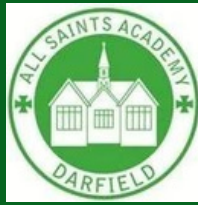

School do not yet have access to pupil outcomes. Results will be reported within the end of year reports.

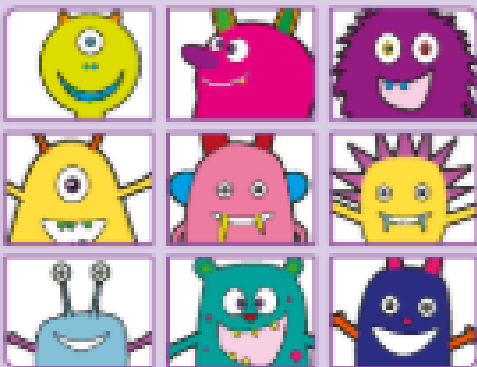


### **URGENT:** Year 2 Yorkshire Wildlife Park

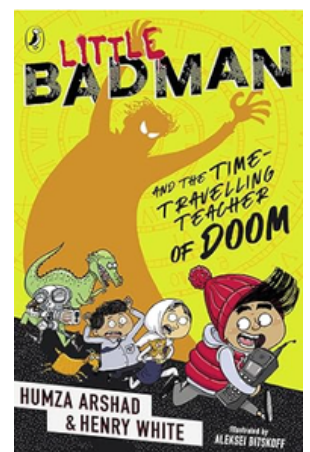
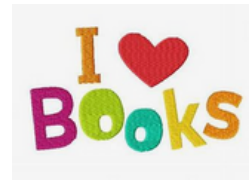
