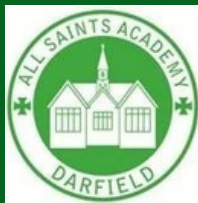

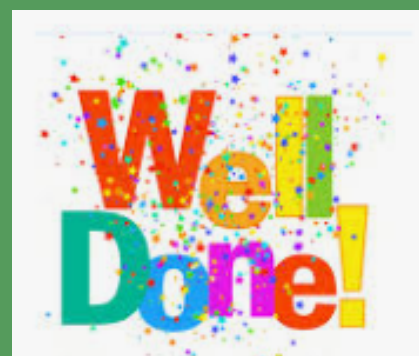
The external provider we are currently working with need the information to be able to make an informed decision about whether it would be financially viable to set up wrap around care at All Saints Academy.

# Recommended books!

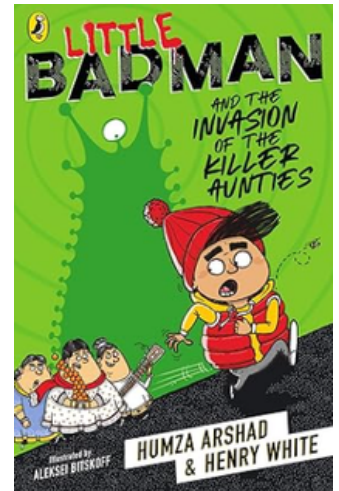
Our Authors in the spotlight this term are Shirley Hughes (KS1) and Hamza Arshad (KS2).
